

ROTC CADETS: CLAIMS PROCESSING FOR IN LINE OF DUTY INJURIES

Effective 01 January 03, all claims for ROTC Cadets with in Line of Duty injuries must be filed with the Department of Labor Workman's Compensation.

The Military Medical Support Office (MMSO) will no longer process these claims, in accordance with the provisions of Public Law 103-3, Section 8140, of the Federal Employees Compensation Act.

The Federal Employee's Compensation Program District Office 25, located in Washington DC, is the point of contact for initiating ROTC Claims. Their contact information is:
